- Coalition for Hindu Girls Abducted and their RIghts
- Over 1000 girls, as young as 8 yrs. old are abducted in Pakistan every year, most are Hindus
- Girls are forcibly converted, trafficked and married to men 3 times their age.
- Awareness campaigns have included online and in-person vigils, webinars, contacting lawmakers
- Work with organizations that advocate for women and against trafficking and sexual exploitation



- Advocate for human rights around the world for all
- Special focus on places where Hindus are a minority. E.g.,
 Bangladesh, Pakistan, Afghanistan etc.
- · Human Rights in Canada
- Advocate for laws like India's CAA that help persecuted Hindus
- Work with the United Nations and other Human Rights organizations
